



PRSL 4S, ZDHC and addendum compliance

Dear Customer,

Our company is happy to support your adhesion to the project which aims to eliminate toxic substances potentially present in the production chain and, and is willing to establish, in mutual interest, an open and effective collaboration.

Our company is equally committed to a policy of continuous improvement of its impact on health and environment; for this reason it has joined the Tessile e Salute project and as a certified company it is able to comply with the limits present in the *Guidelines on eco-toxicological requirement for articles of clothing, leather goods, footwear and accessories* of Camera Nazionale della Moda Italiana (link attached), signed by Sistema Moda Italia, Federchimica and UNIC.

The Tessile e Salute certification monitors our entire supply chain, the use of chemical mixtures used and the compliance with the *Guidelines on eco-toxicological requirements for chemical mixtures* of Camera Nazionale della Moda Italiana (link below), signed by Sistema Moda Italia, Federchimica and UNIC, **which to date are aligned and in some requirements even more restrictive than the MRSL of ZDHC.**

We understand the importance you give to this project, an opportunity to lay the foundations for stable and lasting collaborations along the entire supply chain.

As part of our collaboration and in the gradual elimination of the intentional use of the substances included in the aforementioned RSL, we confirm that:

1. **We are able to comply with the CNMI Article Guidelines. From a comparison with your PRSL 4Sustainability 2020, significant differences and criticalities emerge within the limits you requested, in addition to the misalignments with the ZDHC MRSL adopted by you; in particular we point out that:**
 - a. **The 3 mg/kg and 15 mg/kg limit for AP and APEO respectively is technically inconsistent with the MRSL of ZDHC (we guarantee 100 mg/kg as sum AP+APEO);**
 - b. **The requirements for monochlorophenols and dichlorophenols cannot be guaranteed;**
 - c. **Intentional non-use and the limit of 50 mg/kg of orthophenylphenol are guaranteed.**
2. **We are familiar with the MRSL of ZDHC. We are committed to eliminating the intentional use of hazardous chemicals included in the MRSL of ZDHC from performed and outsourced processes, even through the monitoring of Tessile e Salute and the project supported by the Ministry of Health. We are able to respect and comply with the CNMI Chemical Mixture Guidelines in our supply chain, to date more restrictive in some requirements than the MRSL of ZDHC Foundation.**
3. **We reserve us the right to evaluate the questionnaires submitted and the information requested therein in compliance with the Privacy as well as sensitive company information, even more so if online issued/controlled by third parties, in addition to the evaluation of any other databases registration.**

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4. We certainly respect the REACH Regulation as a cogency and we are updated on recent provisions, updates of Annexes XIV and XVII, as well as monitoring the substances registered in the Candidate List that could potentially be present in our production chain. None of the SVHC substances listed in aforementioned lists to date is INTENTIONALLY USED or present in a concentration greater than 0.1% in our articles.

5. We are willing to share further actions of mutual interest aimed at the continuous improvement of the sustainability of the supply chain.
